Australian based global Film, Television and Online Awards show to go live online October 2011

Apollo Awards Media Release: November 25 2010 – Brisbane, Australia <November 25 is the anniversary of the birth of Ricardo Montalbán, Khan from Star Trek II: The Wrath of Khan>

'The Apollo Awards for Science Fiction & Fantasy Film, Television and Online' to be presented via webcast on Sunday 16th October 2011 (Australian Eastern Standard Time).

Scheduled to air in the United States of America and Europe on Saturday evening, October 15 2011, the webcast will be beamed to the world from Queensland, Australia. The Apollo Awards will deliver a high energy awards ceremony and spectacular visual entertainment, with a host of Australian and New Zealand film & television talent announcing the winners of the public-voted awards.

Traditional categories such as Best Film, Best Series, and Best Actor will be mixed with irreverent – and potentially controversial for fans - award titles such as Coolest Space Ship, Best Space Battle, Best Talking Creature and many more. Included will be nominations for short films, trailers, 'webisodes', and parody entertainment.

Nominations for the awards will open in March, giving the fans the opportunity to select or list their favourites in each category. The top five nominations will be selected for the final round of voting, set to commence in July. Nominations and voting will take place on The Apollo Website, just one part of an interactive online news and community website currently in development by Brisbane online entertainment company Zone4.

Named after the Greek God Apollo, and in honour of the NASA Space missions that saw science fiction become reality with the Apollo Moon Landing in 1969, the inaugural awards will play homage to the name with actors who have played 'Apollo' as featured guests of the ceremony.

Actor Richard Hatch from the *Battlestar Galactica* series of both 1978 and 2004 made the first public announcement of The Apollo Awards during a panel at New York Comic Con in October, where 101010 Productions launched the awards.

"They're going to have fans voting on best show, best performance... best creature... They're going to have everyone participate in that. Watch for it online... sci-fi, fantasy, anime will finally get its due."
